## Building/Location

Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland, is a multicultural city that has something for everybody. There are many museums, art galleries, theatres, monuments, international restaurants, nightclubs and bars. The architecture is among the most magnificent in Europe.

The Aspect ILA school is located right in the centre of Edinburgh, in a beautiful 200 year old building just a 5 minute walk from the city's main shopping area. The school was established in 1995.

## School Facilities

The school has 12 classrooms and a Study Centre including access to 10 computers and audio-visual facilities. Videos, books and CD-ROMs are available for borrowing in the office library. The student common room has recently been renovated and has a TV and video, coffee making facilities, vending machines and a microwave.

## Accommodation

Students are placed in homestays in residential suburbs usually a bus ride away from the school. Accommodation is on a half board or Bed & Breakfast basis. Single and twin rooms are available. Students in twin rooms usually share a room with another nationality or with the same nationality if requested.

Residential accommodation is available upon request.

## Teaching Programme

Lessons take place between 09.00 - 17.00 depending on the course selected and the time of the year. There is always a mid-

morning or mid-afternoon break and a lunch hour.

General English courses focus on consolidating grammar, developing vocabulary and building the confidence to communicate in English in most everyday situations. There is a range of specialist courses available - Premier, Premier Plus, Premier Intensive, English for Business, Cambridge Exam Preparation and Internship Course.

## Activity Programme

We organise a weekly social programme which includes afternoon and evening activities. There are both free activities and activities that require a small fee.

The half-day/evening social programmes include sports, cultural activities and events at the school. There are visits to Edinburgh Castle, Our Dynamic Earth (Edinburgh's new, state-of-the-art attraction), cinema visits, video evenings, Scottish Country dancing, discos, quizzes and international food parties. Full-day excursions in the weekends are organised by a tour company and include the Highlands, Glasgow, St Andrews (the home of golf) and Loch Lomond.
